



Changes agreed to this scheme from 01 December 2023

Due to the ongoing situation in the region at present, the funder DSIT Department for Science, Innovation and Technology have agreed to the following key additions to call 2 of the UK-Israel innovation researcher mobility scheme which is currently open for applications. This has been agreed with the aim of ensuring mobilities can go ahead and scheme objectives can be met.

The application deadline for the scheme has been extended to Tuesday 30 January 2024 at 5pm GMT

Alongside the existing outbound mobility for UK based researchers and research related staff the scheme has also been opened up to allow inbound mobility to the UK by Israeli/OPT based partner



Flat rates
